III. OUTREACH INITIATIVES

The following outreach initiatives were completed by the SEU during the reporting period:

A. <u>Job Fair</u>:

The station employment unit participated in the following job fairs by providing radio advertising for each event during the reporting period. For each event, job description handouts and job postings were provided as well as information and instructions on how to submit resumes and applications to the company's website.

B. Management Training:

1. The Salem Director of Human Resources conducts monthly HR Network Training sessions via teleconference and PowerPoint presentations, which includes review of EEO policies and compliance. The SEU's Business Manager participates in these training sessions

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each month and then routinely communicates with the SEU's General Manager and other management team members to keep all employees apprised of the Company and SEU's policy on equal employment.

C. <u>Training for Higher Level Positions</u>:

The SEU has a training program designed to enable station personnel to acquire skills to qualify for higher level positions. The Promotions Assistant was being cross trained with the Production department and learning how to run boards and be an on-air personality. All training is an on-going effort to prepare these employees for advancement within the company.

D. <u>Mentoring Program for Higher Level Positions</u>:

The SEU has an ongoing mentoring program designed to enable station personnel to acquire skills to qualify for higher level positions. Various station personnel mentor other employees at least two times per month, which includes mentoring a Sales Manager for a General Manager position and mentoring a Talk Show Producer for an Operations Director position should any become available locally or elsewhere in the chain.

E. Other Activities:

The SEU considers the opportunity to give children and community members tours of the radio stations a chance for them to learn about radio and media therefore, possibly peak an interest in future careers.

- **1.** On March 20th 2017 a group from Mrs. Stuzman's 4th grade class from Southwest Bible School had a studio tour lead by our Talk Show host.
- **2.** On March 24th 2017 a group of 20 people from Mt. Hood Adult Day Center had a studio tour lead by our Promotions Director.
