III. OUTREACH INITIATIVES

The following outreach initiatives were completed by the SEU during the reporting period:

A. Participation in Job Fairs:

The SEU participated in the following job fairs listed below. During each job fair, the station employment unit handed out information on career opportunities in broadcasting, solicited applications and collected resumes.

B. Job Banks and Internet Programs:

(1) The SEU participated in job banks and internet programs designed to provide general information about opportunities in broadcasting and to encourage job seekers to consider future employment. Job openings have been posted on web sites to ensure broad internet recruitment. During this reporting period the following job banks and web sites were used.

C. Management Training:

(1) The Salem Director of Human Resources conducts monthly HR Network Training sessions via webinar and Power Point presentations, which

includes review of EEO policies and compliance. The SEU's Business Manager participates in these training sessions each month then routinely communicates with the SEU's General Manager and other management team members to keep all employees apprised of the company and SEU's policy on equal employment.

(2) The SEU participates in an on-line ethics and harassment training program through Gallagher Bassett Risk Control Consulting Service, which is an ongoing program for managers to train them in methods of ensuring equal employment opportunity and preventing discrimination. During this reporting period, one SEU employee participated in the On-line training program.

D. Training Program for Higher Level Positions:

(1) The SEU has established a training program designed to enable station personnel to acquire skills that will qualify them for a higher level position. During this reporting the SEU's receptionist is currently training with the Business Manager and Traffic Coordinator that will qualify for a higher level position as Traffic Coordinator.

E. Other Activities:

(1) The SEU offers tours to schools, youth groups, community groups and other entities to provide information about the broadcasting industry and careers in broadcasting. Tours were conducted on February 12, 2018 with students from Arizona Christian University and on May, 7 2018 with 40 students from Emmanuel Lutheran School
