#### III. OUTREACH INITIATIVES

The following outreach initiatives were completed by the SEU during the reporting period:

# A. <u>Job Fair</u>:

The station employment unit participated in the following job fairs by providing radio advertising for each event during the reporting period. For each event, job description handouts and job postings were provided as well as information and instructions on how to submit resumes and applications to the company's website.

- 1. On February 24, 2016, the SEU participated in The City of Portland's Annual Diversity Employment Day Career Fair held at the Ambridge Events Center, 133 NE MLK Jr. Blvd., Portland, OR 97232. The SEU did on-air advertisements and the SEU was listed as a Co-Media Sponsor and Diversity Partner.
- 2. On May 10, 2016, the SEU participated in the National Career Fair held at Sheraton Portland Airport Hotel, 8235 NE Airport Way, Portland, Oregon 97220. The SEU Did on-air advertisements for the career fair.

# B. <u>Management Training</u>:

- 1. The Salem Director of Human Resources conducts monthly HR Network Training sessions via teleconference and PowerPoint presentations, which includes review of EEO policies and compliance. The SEU's Business Manager participates in these training sessions each month and then routinely communicates with the SEU's General Manager and other management team members to keep all employees apprised of the Company and SEU's policy on equal employment.
- 2. All of the current Account Executives participated in Sales and Digital training with Advantage systems. Learning new techniques and skills for selling radio and digital advertising.

## C. <u>Training for Higher Level</u> Positions:

The SEU has a training program designed to enable station personnel to acquire skills to qualify for higher level positions. The Promotions Assistant was being cross trained with the traffic department and learning how to use Wide Orbit, he has now been promoted to Traffic Director. All training is an on-going effort to prepare these employees for advancement within the company.

## D. <u>Mentoring Program for Higher Level Positions</u>:

The SEU has an ongoing mentoring program designed to enable station personnel to acquire skills to qualify for higher level positions. Various station personnel mentor other employees at least two times per month, which includes mentoring a Sales Manager for a General Manager position and mentoring a Talk Show Producer for an Operations Director position should any become available locally or elsewhere in the chain.

# E. Other Activities:

The SEU considers the opportunity to give children tours of the radio stations a chance for them to learn about radio and media therefore, possibly peak an interest in future careers.

- 1. On November 6, 2015 a group from First Class Clackamas Teens home school group had a studio tour lead by our Promotions Director.
- 2. On November 19<sup>th</sup> students and chaperones from the Adult Transition Program at North Clackamas School District had a studio tour lead by our Promotions Director.
- **3.** On March 2<sup>nd</sup> a group from the Audio Production class from George Fox University had a studio tour lead by our Promotions Director.
- **4.** On March 4, 2016 a tour was led by our Talk Show Host to a group of children from Southwest Christian School from the Beaverton area.
- **5.** On March 18, 2016 Cub Scout Pack 259 had a studio tour lead by our Promotions Director.
- **6.** On May 5, 2016 a group from Cornerstone Christian Academy had a studio tour lead by our Promotions Director.
