III. OUTREACH INITIATIVES

The following outreach initiatives were completed by the SEU during the reporting period:

A. Participation in Job Fairs:

The SEU participated in the following job fairs listed below. During each job fair, the station employment unit handed out information on career opportunities in broadcasting, solicited applications and collected resumes.

- (1) <u>Arizona Broadcasters Career Fair</u> May 12, 2016 Mesa AZ: The SEU's Business Manager and Traffic Coordinator attended.
- (2) <u>Arizona State University Summer Career Fair</u> May 24, 2016 Tempe AZ: The SEU's Business Manager attended

B. Job Banks and Internet Programs:

The SEU participated in job banks and internet programs designed to provide general information about opportunities in broadcasting and to encourage job seekers to consider future employment. Job openings have been posted on web sites to ensure broad internet recruitment. During this reporting period the following job banks and web sites were used.

C. Management Training:

- (1) The Salem Director of Human Resources conducts monthly HR Network Training sessions via webinar and Power Point presentations, which includes review of EEO policies and compliance. The SEU's Business Manager participates in these training sessions each month then routinely communicates with the SEU's General Manager and other management team members to keep all employees apprised of the company and SEU's policy on equal employment.
- (2) The SEU participates in an on-line ethics and harassment training program through Gallagher Bassett Risk Control Consulting Service, which is an ongoing program for managers to train them in methods of ensuring equal employment opportunity and preventing discrimination. Training modules include "Ethics in Action" and "Prevention of

- Harassment and Discrimination". During this reporting period, one SEU employee participated in the On-line training program.
- (3) The SEU's Business Manager participated in a Staffing Network Webcast hosted by the Arizona Broadcasters Association to train on recruitment and where to publicize vacancies to attract a broader and new range of candidates.

D. Internship Program:

This program is designed to provide students with practical experience through participation so that they gain a fuller understanding of the broadcast industry and expand their skill sets. The Business Manager of the SEU works with the students to establish a schedule that will accomplish this. The program ran for 16 weeks with the student logging 135 hours, receiving a total of 3 academic credits.
