On January 22, 1973, the Supreme Court decision Roe v. Wade legalized abortion in the United States.





A 2009 public survey found that 86% of Americans supported abortion up until the sixth month of pregnancy and 6%-17% supported abortion **being legal at any time**.

Abortions on women with family income below 100% of the federal poverty level: 49%

Abortions on women with incomes from 100%-199% of the federal poverty level: 26%

Recognize the Numbers

332,757

In 2017, Planned Parenthood was responsible for 36% of abortions in the United States, totaling a number of 332,757.

A 2019 August survey showed whether Americans considered themselves pro-life or pro-choice regarding abortion from the years 2003 to 2019. In 2019, 46% were pro-choice, while pro-life supports were 49%.
