pro-life ( $\boldsymbol{n}$ ): opposing abortion \& protecting the life of a newborn. How do we do that? How can we support mothers and families?

On January 22, 1973, the Supreme Court decision Roe v. Wade legalized abortion in the United States.


A 2009 public survey found that $86 \%$ of Americans supported abortion up until the sixth month of pregnancy and $6 \%-17 \%$ supported abortion being legal at any time.

Abortions on women with family income below $100 \%$ of the federal poverty level: 49\%
Abortions on women with incomes from 100\%-199\% of the
federal poverty level: $26 \%$

## Recognize the Numbers

## 332,757

In 2017, Planned Parenthood was responsible
for $36 \%$ of abortions in the United States, totaling a number of 332,757.

A 2019 August survey showed whether Americans considered themselves pro-life or pro-choice regarding abortion from the years 2003 to 2019. In 2019, 46\% were pro-choice, while pro-life supports were $49 \%$.

In 2018, a spring poll concluded that $\mathbf{5 5 \%}$ of Americans said that abortion should be legal in all or most cases.
