III. OUTREACH INITIATIVES

The following outreach initiatives were completed by the SEU during the reporting period:

A. Job Fair Participation: Station staff members attended various job fairs in-person and met prospective applicants. B. Management Training: The Salem VP of Human Resources conducts monthly HR Network Training sessions via teleconference and Powerpoint presentations, which includes review of EEO policies and compliance. The SEU's Office Manager participates in these training sessions each month and then routinely communicates with the SEU's General Manager and other management team members to keep all employees apprised of the company and SEU's policy on equal employment.

C. Internship Program: WMCA and WNYM hosted one intern during this reporting period from the general public and from students currently enrolled in Hofstra University. The interns observed and worked alongside various staff members in the programming department. The program introduced college students and interested community members to the field of broadcast program creation and the workings of a professional radio environment.
